1. How does Satan's mindset (Isaiah 14:12-15) compare to Christ's mindset (Philippians 2:5-9), and who is your mindset patterned after?

3. How would you feel if Jesus wanted to wash your feet? How do you feel about washing the feet of the 'Judas' in your life?
4. What is it about Christ's humiliation that motivates humility on your part?
5. Steadfastness requires Unity, unity requires humility, practically where can we begin?

Philippians 2:5-9 Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, 6 who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but made himself nothing, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

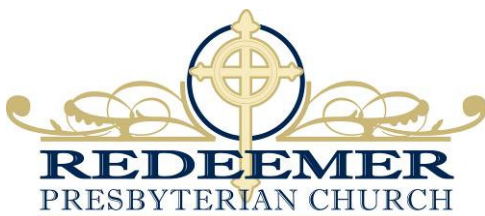
*These verses uniquely unfold the cross as seen through the eyes of the Crucified, and allow us to enter into the mind of Christ. We tread, therefore, on very holy ground indeed. **We do well to remember that this privilege is given to us not to satisfy our curiosity but to reform our lives.** - Alec Motyer*

Having the mind of Christ will help us to live for Christ.

The Incarnation shows us what the *mind of Christ* (5) is:

- **Jesus becoming man (the Incarnation)**
 - Humility in heaven (6)
 - Humility becoming man (7)
 - Humility submitting Himself to death (8)
- **What does this (the Incarnation) mean for us?**
- **What should this (the Incarnation) do to our lives?**
