4. How does God's promise to safeguard and protect His church encourage you personally?

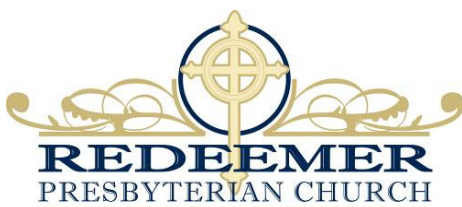
SERMON OUTLINE

***We're not much, but we're His***      1 Corinthians 3:16-17

**1 Corinthians 3:16-17** [16] Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? [17] If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.

***We are Christ's Church, and nothing could be more precious to God.***

- Christ's Church is God's Temple
