PART THREE : A Hymn of Thanksgiving for the final overthrow of Death

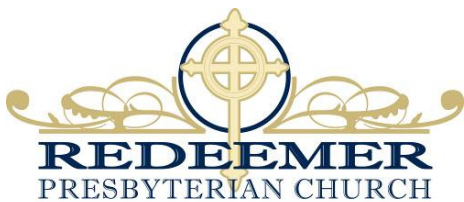
46. I Corinthians 15:21-22
