I. Let love be genuine.

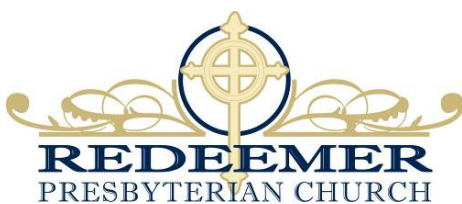
II. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good.
