## SERMON OUTLINE

*To Live is Christ*  
March 14, 2010

Philippians 1:19-26  
Pastor Tony Felich

**Philippians 1:18** What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed, and in that I rejoice. Yes, and I will rejoice, **19** for I know that through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Christ this will turn out for my deliverance, **20** as it is my eager expectation and hope that I will not be at all ashamed, but that with full courage now as always Christ will be honored in my body, whether by life or by death. **21** For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. **22** If I am to live in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me. Yet which I shall choose I cannot tell. **23** I am hard pressed between the two. My desire is to depart and be with Christ, for that is far better. **24** But to remain in the flesh is more necessary on your account. **25** Convinced of this, I know that I will remain and continue with you all, for your progress and joy in the faith, **26** so that in me you may have ample cause to glory in Christ Jesus, because of my coming to you again.

Here we learn the bible's entire philosophy of life and death. which is wrapped up in the sovereign activity of God.

**Heidelberg Q. 1. What is thy only comfort in life and death?**

*A. That I with body and soul, both in life and death, am not my own, but belong unto my faithful Saviour Jesus Christ...*

**Westminster Shorter Catechism Q. 1. What is the chief end of man?**

*A. Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever.*

- ***The Advance of the Gospel and the progress of our faith is the chief way God achieves His goal***
