3. Is there a "Paul" in your life that has encouraged and emboldened you to be more "confident in the Lord" (v. 14)?
4. How can our criticism, envy and rivalry of other ministries be subdued and good will, sincerity, and love take their place (v. 15-17)? How does rejoicing (v. 18) figure in?

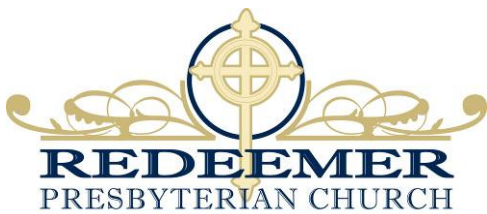
Philippians 1:12-18

Philippians 1:9 And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment, **10** so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, **11** filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God. **12** I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel, **13** so that it has become known throughout the whole imperial guard and to all the rest that my imprisonment is for Christ. **14** And most of the brothers, having become confident in the Lord by my imprisonment, are much more bold to speak the word without fear. **15** Some indeed preach Christ from envy and rivalry, but others from good will. **16** The latter do it out of love, knowing that I am put here for the defense of the gospel. **17** The former proclaim Christ out of rivalry, not sincerely but thinking to afflict me in my imprisonment. **18** What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed, and in that I rejoice.

For His own glory, God uses all kinds of circumstances and people to advance the gospel- there is no stopping it.

- *The intended goal for our spiritual fruitfulness is the glory of God (9-11)*
- *Trials will not stop the progress of the gospel, in fact, they are used by God to advance it! (12-14)*
- *Preaching with Bad motives can't even stop the advance of the gospel! (15-18)*
