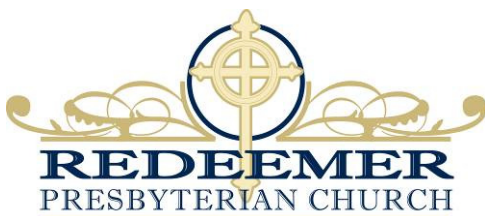

Daniel 1:1-7

[1] In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah,
Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came to Jerusalem and besieged it. [2]
And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand,
