**Luke 3:23** Jesus, when he began his ministry, was about thirty years of age, being **the son (as was supposed) of Joseph**, the son of Heli...[31] the son of Melea, the son of Menna, the son of Mattatha, the son of Nathan, **the son of David**...[34] the son of Jacob, the son of Isaac, **the son of Abraham**, the son of Terah, the son of Nahor, ...[38] the son of Enos, the son of Seth, **the son of Adam**, the son of God.

**Acts 13:21** Then they asked for a king, and God gave them Saul the son of Kish, a man of the tribe of Benjamin, for forty years. [22] And when he had removed him, he raised up David to be their king, of whom he testified and said, 'I have found in David the son of Jesse a man after my heart, who will do all my will.' [23] Of this man's offspring God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus, as he promised.

**Romans 5:15** But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many.
