APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. How did Tony's survey of the use of the word "mind" in Scripture broaden your understanding? (Ex 14:5, Num 23:19, 1Sam. 9:19, 1Kings 3:9-12, Mk. 12:30, Rom. 12:2, 1 Cor.2:16, Eph. 2:3, Phil. 1:27; 2:2-5)
2. Describe a situation where God has guarded your heart and mind and give praise to God.
3. How does the picture of the Worth Lamb of God in Rev. 5 shape what we are to think on for you?
4. Why is "practicing these things" (v 9) so tied to "thinking these things" (v 8)?

Filling Your Mind

Philippians 4:8-9
Pastor Tony Felich

Philippians 4:4-9 Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. 5 Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; 6 do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. [9] What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me—practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.

Closely related to realizing the peace of God is filling our minds with the right thing(s) and living in light of them.

- **Rejoice/Be reasonable/Pray thankfully/Know God's peace (4-7)**
- **Fill your mind with the right thing(s) (8)**
 - True Things
 - Honorable things
 - Just things
 - Pure things
 - Lovely things
 - Commendable things
 - Excellent things
 - Praise worthy things
- **Live in light of these things (9)**
