Matthew 28 and Colossians 1

Matthew 28:18-20 [18] And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. [19] Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, [20] teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

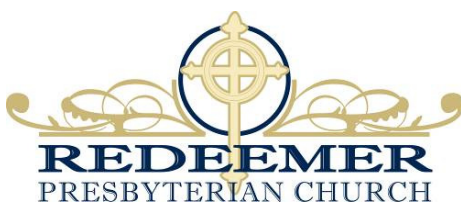
Colossians 1:25b-29 [25b] ... to make the word of God fully known, [26] the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints. [27] To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. [28] Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. [29] For this I toil, struggling with all his energy that he powerfully works within me.

Mission: *Redeemer is a community of Christians who love to worship their God, study His Word, and proclaim His gospel to the world.*

Vision: *Redeemer strives, by God's grace to be a center for the worship of God in our community and a training ground for disciples of Jesus Christ.*

The four components of Redeemer's mission/vision-

- **Worship:** *We are redeemed to bring God the glory He deserves!*
- **The Word:** *The bible is our rule for faith and life.*
- **Community:** *We are a family of sinners redeemed by God's grace through Christ.*
- **Proclamation:** *We want to share Jesus with others through what we say and do.*
