Philippians 3:20-4:1

3:17-4:1 17 Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us. 18 For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. 19 Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things. 20 But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, 21 who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself. 4:1 Therefore, my brothers, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm thus in the Lord, my beloved.

Life in the present is to be shaped and settled by an awareness of where we belong and where we are going.

What is true:

- **We are not earth bound (19)-in Christ, we are citizens of heaven!(20)**
- **Christ will finish the work He began in us! (20b-21)**

What to do:

- **Stand firm in Christ (4:1)**
