3. What happens when we force issues and go ahead in the flesh similar to Abraham? Share examples.
4. What happens when we wait on God's promises instead? Share examples.

Galatians 4:21-31

Paul uses a recognized historical account to illustrate how we are made right with God not by works (flesh) but by faith (Spirit).

- Paul warns in the form of a question (21)
- The historical account used by Paul (22-23)
- The allegory used by Paul (24-27)
- The application of this allegory to us by Paul (28-31)

### Slavery (in the flesh)

Hagar- a slave woman  
Ishmael- born according to flesh  
The Old Covenant *misapplied*  
Earthly Jerusalem  
Judaism (*think they are justified by works*)  
In the flesh

### Freedom (in the Spirit)

Sarah- a free woman  
Isaac- born through promise  
The New Covenant  
Heavenly Jerusalem  
Christianity (*justified by faith*)  
In the Spirit
