<p>Isaiah 66: 18 “For I know their works and their thoughts, and the time is coming to gather all nations and tongues. And they shall come and shall see my glory, [19] and I will set a sign among them. And from them I will send survivors to the nations, to Tarshish, Pul, and Lud, who draw the bow, to Tubal and Javan, to the coastlands far away, that have not heard my fame or seen my glory. And they shall declare my glory among the nations. [20] And they shall bring all your brothers from all the nations as an offering to the Lord, on horses and in chariots and in litters and on mules and on dromedaries, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, says the Lord, just as the Israelites bring their grain offering in a clean vessel to the house of the Lord. [21] And some of them also I will take for priests and for Levites, says the Lord. [22] “For as the new heavens and the new earth that I make shall remain before me, says the Lord, so shall your offspring and your name remain. [23] From new moon to new moon, and from Sabbath to Sabbath, all flesh shall come to worship before me, declares the Lord. [24] “And they shall go out and look on the dead bodies of the men who have rebelled against me. For their worm shall not die, their fire shall not be quenched, and they shall be an abhorrence to all flesh.”</p>	<p>God is working to draw all people to witness his eternal glory.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">I. Sermon Application Questions

1. Discuss Jerome's statement. Do you agree or disagree?
"Isaiah should be called an evangelist rather than a prophet because he describes all the mysteries of Christ and the Church so clearly that you would think he is composing a history of what has already happened rather than prophesying about what is to come." -St. Jerome of the late 4th Century
2. Discuss what is meant by God's glory in verses 18-19.
3. How is the missionary effort of the Church related to this passage?
4. Discuss your favorite teaching from Isaiah.
5. Discuss this final statement adapted from Alec Motyer:
There is a grandeur about Isaiah not found elsewhere even in the most majestic portions of the rest of Scripture.
But with Isaiah's grandeur there is a stern resoluteness. If Isaiah's description of God's glory does not win us to the life of obedience, if visions of the coming King, the sin-bearing Servant and the liberating Anointed Conqueror will not suffice, then maybe the unmistakably horrible rewards of disobedience will drive our wayward hearts to tremble at the Word of the Lord.
