<p><b>Matthew 1:18</b> Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. [19] And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. [20] But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, “Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. [21] She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.” [22] All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet:</p>	<p>I. Jesus – The savior of sinners (Matt. 1:20)</p> <p>II. Jesus – The giver of eternal life (John 20:30)</p> <p>III. Jesus – The provider of purpose (Col. 3:17)</p> <p>IV. ## Sermon Application Questions

1. How are personal names significant? What significant names do you have in your family? Why were you named as you are?

2. Discuss what Joseph might have been thinking/feeling with the announcement about Jesus' purpose.

3. When does eternal life start for a believer and why is this an important distinction to make?

4. How does Colossians 3:17 impact our outlook on life?

5. Discuss this statement from JC Ryle - The praise of the Lord Jesus will be the eternal song of all the inhabitants of heaven. They will say with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain. Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be to Him that sitteth on the throne, and to the Lamb for ever and ever."

The service of the Lord Jesus will be one eternal occupation of all the inhabitants of heaven. We shall "serve Him day and night in His temple." Blessed is the thought that we shall at length attend on Him without distraction, and work for Him without weariness.

The presence of Christ Himself shall be one ever lasting enjoyment of the inhabitants of heaven. We shall "see His face," and hear His voice, and speak with Him as friend with friend. Sweet is the thought that whosoever may be wanting at the marriage supper, the Master Himself will be there. His presence will satisfy all our wants.
