God Graciously Renews Us in Christ

§ We Confess Our Sin

Holy Lord, You are exalted above all nations, robed in majesty, enthroned from of old. You are holy. We confess that we are not. We have not loved You with our whole heart, nor our neighbors as ourselves. We have spoken Your name without reverence, worshiped without awe, and lived as though Your holiness made no claim upon us. We have not been a holy people. We have not reflected Your character to a watching world. We do not come pleading our own righteousness, for we have none. We come because You are merciful. Your Son, who knew no sin, became sin for us, so that we might stand before Your holiness without being consumed. O Lord, hear. O Lord, forgive. O Lord, restore us, not for our sake, but for the sake of Your great name and the glory of Your Son. Amen.

§ God Forgives Us in Christ Romans 8:31-34

If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him graciously give us all things? Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. *In Jesus Christ our sins are forgiven!*
