§ We Confess Our Sin

Almighty God we confess that we have been taken captive by hollow philosophy and human tradition, rather than being rooted and built up in Christ, in whom the whole fullness of deity dwells. We have looked for fullness in success, comfort, and our own opinions, instead of in Him. We confess that we walk more often by the wisdom of this age than by the truth of your Word, trusting our own judgment above your revelation. Merciful Father, we come to you not on the ground of any record we can offer, for our record stands against us. We appeal again to the finished work of our Savior Jesus Christ. Through Him our sin debt is canceled. Because of Christ, You have set aside every charge against us, and our guilt has been nailed to the cross where Jesus triumphed over every power that would hold us captive. Amen.
